

## What to Bring and What NOT to Bring to Camp

### **Here are some things you will want to bring to camp with you:**

Sleeping bag or linens and pillow

Bible

Writing paper

Pencil or pen

Towels, washcloth, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc

Sunscreen

Non-aerosol insect repellent

Money for offering

Balance of your camp fee if you have not paid in full

Money for Point Shop – NOTE the Point Shop will only be open on the day you arrive and the day you leave.

Stamps, envelopes and paper for writing letters home

Water bottle

Fishing gear (optional)

Camera (and film if needed) (optional)

### **Here are some things you should NOT bring to camp**

Electronic games

Boom Boxes, ipods, mp3 players, etc

Food or candy

Aerosol cans

Tobacco of any kind

Cell phones

Fireworks, Firearms, etc

Anything that might upset you if you lost it

Please note---- Medical forms for minor must be signed by a parent or guardian and mailed to camp at least two weeks prior to the start of your camp.
